Part B

Dog Fouling/ASB – Discussion and broad agreement on strategy/Comms moving forward.

- Antisocial behaviour on Millenium Green is minimal – instances of electric bikes etc.

A dog attacked another dog 18 months ago-owner walking 4 dogs dropped lead and one of the dogs attacked another dog. Incident reported to police -owner given a community order to walk dog with muzzle which has now expired.

Owner is walking the dog now without a muzzle, it lunges towards other dogs whilst being walked around the green, which is a cause of concern to some residents who feel they are unable to let their dogs off lead in case there is another incident.

Police suggest sending a letter requesting she muzzles the dog if she walks the dog on the Millenium Green. Even though a dog is on the lead if it attacks another dog it may well breach the PSPO as the dog must be under control at all times. If she doesn't comply then police said they would try to support WPC moving forward.
